Highlighted TAM Program Updates



TAM Plan: Horizon, Updates, and Amendments

- TAM Plans must be updated in their entirety at least every 4 years
 - First plans complete by October 2018
 - Update plans by October 2022
- You may need to update sooner if:
 - Significant unexpected changes:
 - asset inventory
 - condition assessments
 - investment prioritization
 - Realign with other internal or regional planning processes

For detailed requirements, see 49 CFR §625.29.

TAM Plan: Facility Condition Assessments

- Agencies must submit facility condition assessments to NTD every year.
 - At least 25% reported each year of TAM plan horizon
 - —By RY19 reported at least 50%




Update: TAMPLATE 2.0

- Updating Technical assistance tool based on feedback from rollout
- Replaces Small Provider Excel Template
- Automatically populates TAM (AIM) data from NTD.



- manage the investment prioritization processes.






