Applicability

Mandatory

Regulation

- State Safety Oversight Agency (SSOA) employees and contractors who conduct safety audits and examinations
- Rail Transit Agency (RTA) employees and contractors who are directly responsible for safety oversight

Voluntary

- Bus transit system personnel with direct safety oversight responsibility
- State Department of Transportation (DOT) agencies overseeing safety programs for subrecipients of Federal financial assistance



Status

Requirements

- PTSCTP participants must complete the initial training requirements of the PTSCTP within three years of enrolling into the program
- PTSCTP participants must complete refresher training every two years upon completing the initial training requirements
 - Each agency (i.e., SSOA or RTA) must identify required refresher training for individuals (staff and/or contractors) designated by the agency under the PTSCTP
 - The refresher training requirement must include a minimum of one hour of safety oversight training
 - Individuals who complete PTSCTP requirements will be provided a certificate of completion
- SSOAs and RTAs must certify compliance as part of the FTA annual certifications and assurances process




