Assault Awareness and Prevention for Transit Operators Training for the Transit Industry



The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) offers resources to support transit agencies as they work toward implementing the Federal mask requirement while ensuring the safety of transit operators. With our partner, the National Transit Institute (NTI), FTA provides training for transit bus operators on assault awareness and prevention.

The virtual *Assault Awareness and Prevention for Transit Operators (Direct Delivery)* course provides transit bus operators with prevention strategies necessary to reduce the likelihood of assault incidents.
