#### What is an ESMS?

An environmental and sustainability management system is a set of management processes and procedures that allows an organization to analyze, control and reduce the environmental impact of its activities, products and services, and operate with a greater efficiency and control. An ESMS is useful for organizations of any size in both the public and private sectors.

#### The basic elements of an ESMS include:

- Identifying relevant environmental aspects and associated impacts
- Identifying objectives and goals
- → Identifying compliance obligations
- Monitoring and measuring progress
- Ensuring employees' environmental awareness and competence
- ★ Reviewing ESMS progress and making improvements

#### What Are The Benefits?

An ESMS provides tools to help manage your organization's environmental impacts efficiently and to improve environmental stewardship across the entire organization.

#### **Benefits include:**

- Reductions in environmental impacts, such as resources consumed, waste, and emissions
- Enhanced public image with system users and the general public
- Improved communications and cooperation through training and outreach
- Reinforcement of environmental processes currently in place
- → Proactive management of environmental issues
- Captures employee knowledge ("institutional memory")
- Documentation of standard operating procedures
- → Increased operational efficiencies

- → Baseline Environmental Review at each participating transit agency facility (Summer 2024)
- ★ Three Virtual Workshops (Fall 2024 Spring 2025)
- Gap Audit conducted virtually for each participating transit agency (2025)
- Final Audit at each participating transit agency facility (2025)
