

Safety Data and Information Collection

Part 674 requires SSOAs to establish policies and procedures for collecting and reviewing data used by RTAs in hazard identification and safety risk assessment.

RTAs are increasingly gathering more data, using advanced tools, and employing complex trends to analyze safety information.




