RAIL SAFETY STAFF TRAINING



- CATS and FTA required training
 - Transit Safety and Security Program (TSSP)Certification
 - Public Transportation Safety Certification Training Program (PTSCTP) Certificate
- Specialized training in
 - ▶ Root Cause Analysis
 - Emergency Preparedness
 - ► TSA First Observe Plus security training
- - Rail Operations/Operator Training
 - Rail Car Maintenance
 - Track and Systems
 - Traction Power
 - > Signals


Safety Event Response Structure

- CATS S&S03 Safety Event/Accident/Incident Investigation and Reporting Policy
- ▶ Why this process?
 - ▶ Industry Best Practices
 - Lessons Learned from past events and rail incident investigation training
 - Federal Regulations and State Safety Oversight Program Standards (SSOPS)



RTA SAFETY EVENT INVESTIGATIONS

The policy describes how to respond to an event, which includes the following main topics:







▶ Initial Response

- ▷ Identifies who needs to respond based on event type
 - Rail Operations Control Center (ROCC) contacts internal and external resources depending on event (safety vs. security)

▷ On-scene/Notifications

- On-scene activities
 - ▷ CATS personnel responds to events with specific roles and responsibilities
 - ▷ CATS Safety and Security (S&S) personnel, once on scene, assume IC
 - ▶ Formal internal notifications are made (i.e., Leadership, Risk Management, Legal, Communications/PIO, etc.)
 - ▶ Formal external notifications are made (i.e., SSOA/FTA 2-hour, FRA, NTSB, TSA, etc.) based on the event
 - ▶ Pictures, initial interviews, measurements, summary of events, diagrams, etc.
 - ▷ S&S staff concur with rail operations staff to ensure it is safe to remove the train from event site and either return train back to service or out of service back to a yard





Post-event

- Steps taken to safely and properly clear an event so CATS can return to normal service
- ▶ Pull data based on type of event
 - Video, TDX, power sub-station, signal house, audio, etc.
 - Conduct interviews
 - Rail Operations initial reports

Preliminary Report

- ▶ Interviews
- ∨ Vehicle downloads
- Video and audio review and downloads
- ▷ Initial determination of preventable vs. unpreventable
- Create maps of event location







Continued investigation

- > Process to follow to investigate event
 - ▶ As necessary return to event location and take additional measurements, pictures, etc.
 - Review collected data
 - Conduct follow-up interviews

 - ▷ Determine if event was preventable vs. unpreventable
 - Draft initial CAPS

▷ CAPS

- Process to follow if corrective actions are identified
 - Identify corrective action plans
 - ▶ Follow SSOPS
 - Enter CAPS in database
 - Track CAPS until closure





▶ Final Report

- ▶ Follow template laid out in SSOPS
- Determine preventable vs. unpreventable
- Determine contributing factors
- ▶ Identify violations and associate CAPS as applicable

▶ If safety trends are identified

- Create Bulletins or Notices to adjust current operations to address identified issues
- ▶ Provide additional training, refresher training, or adjust training
- ▶ Update polices and procedures or create new processes to address identified issues
