This letter concerns the Federal Transit Administration's (FTA) Title VI Review of Foothill Transit conducted from September 30, 2015. Enclosed is a copy of the Final Report, which will be posted on FTA's website on our Title VI page. As of the date of this letter, the Final Report is a public document and is subject to dissemination under the Freedom of Information Act of 1974.

The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Office of Civil Rights is responsible for ensuring compliance with 49 CFR Part 21, "Nondiscrimination in Federally-Assisted Programs of the Department of Transportation (DOT)—Effectuation of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (Title VI)" by its grant recipients and subrecipients. As part of our ongoing oversight efforts, FTA conducts a number of onsite compliance reviews to ensure compliance with the Title VI and the applicable departmental regulations. FTA utilizes the findings from these reviews to provide technical assistance to transit agencies in order to achieve compliance with Title VI.

All corrective actions identified in the Final Report must be undertaken within 60 days of the date of this letter. Once we have reviewed your submissions, we will either request clarification or additional corrective action, or will close out the finding if your response sufficiently addresses the Title VI requirements.
