Dear Mr. Dancy:

In a charter service decision issued by the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Regional Administrator Marisol Simon, dated October 16, 2007, Pekin Municipal Bus Service (PMBS) was found to be in violation of FTA's charter service regulation, 49 CFR Part 604. PMBS received the decision on October 19, 2007, and appealed the decision to me on October 29, 2007.

The charter service regulation provides that the Administrator will only take action on an appeal, if the appellant presents evidence that there are new matters of fact or points of law that were not available or not known during the investigation of the complaint, 49 CFR Section 604.19.

In accordance with the charter service regulation, I am not taking any action on the appeal since PMBS presented no new matters of fact or points of law that were not available or not known during the investigation of the complaint, as required by Section 604.19 of the regulation. Accordingly, Regional Administrator Simon's decision is administratively final.
