# Regulations

- 49 USC 5329(e)(2)(b) requires that the SSOA oversee "a rail fixed guideway public transportation system in the engineering or construction phase."
- Rail fixed guideway public transportation system:

Any fixed guideway system that uses rail, is operated for public transportation, is within the jurisdiction of a State, and is not subject to the jurisdiction of the Federal Railroad Administration, or any such system in engineering or construction. (Part 674 Definition)



- SSOA plans and procedures to address RTAs in operations, engineering and construction phases
- Applicable sections of the Program Standard to specify the process for overseeing new systems:
  - Program Management
  - Oversight of Agency Safety Plan
  - SSOA Triennial Audits and Inspections
  - Corrective Actions



- Program Management activities for New Systems
  - Development of independent project oversight plan
  - Coordination meetings
  - Committee participation
  - Project documents subject to SSOA review
  - Project activities for SSOA participation



- Oversight of Agency Safety Plans for New Systems
  - Project-specific hazard and risk management
    - Preliminary Hazard Analysis
    - Operational Hazard Analysis
    - Ongoing resolution of project hazards
  - Safety Certification
    - Reference development of Safety Certification Plan
    - Safety Certification Verification Report



- SSOA Audits/Inspections for New Systems
  - Independent inspections of project infrastructure
    - Track, power, signal, communications, facilities
  - SSOA pre-revenue assessment of project
  - System Safety Program Plan approval and oversight of implementation



- Corrective Actions for New Systems
  - Deviations/changes not completed
  - Open project hazard/risk mitigations
  - Procedures or training programs
  - Delays in procurement or testing
  - Workarounds from safety certification process
  - Findings and recommendations from audits and reviews
    - Internal, SSOA, APTA, FTA Region/Project Management Oversight Contractor (PMOC), TSO



### **Coordination with External Reviews**

#### FTA Regional Oversight of New System

- Approval of Project Management Plan and sub-plan
  - Safety & Security Management/Certification Plans, Quality Management, Construction Safety, etc.
  - Review of plans to enter major phases (engineering, award of funding, construction, etc.)
- Onsite safety reviews
  - Readiness to Enter Revenue Operations Review (OP 54)
  - Safety and Security Management Review (OP 22)



### **Coordination with External Reviews**

#### TSO Oversight of New System

- Reviews PMOC and SSOA reports and safety approval
  - Discusses project safety concerns and oversight of safety plans
  - Coordinates with FTA Regional Office and SSOA to conduct joint review
- Onsite Safety and Security Readiness Review (SSRR)
- SSRR process under FTA evaluation for ongoing approach
  - Workgroup conducted 10 meetings and recommendations being reviewed by TSO
