This notice announces the availability of \$15,074,963 million in funding provided by the Public Transportation on Indian Reservations Program (Tribal Transit Program (TTP)), a program authorized by the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU), Section 3013(c).

This notice is a national solicitation for grant proposals and it includes the selection criteria and program eligibility information for FY 2010 projects. This announcement is available on the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Web site at <http://www.fta.dot.gov>. FTA will announce final selections on the Web site and in the Federal Register. A synopsis of the funding opportunity will be posted in the FIND module of the government wide electronic grants Web site at <http://www.grants.gov>.

Applicants proposing projects for funding under TTP may apply through GRANTS.GOV or via email at fta.tribalprogram@dot.gov. Those who apply via GRANTS.GOV should receive two confirmation emails. The first will confirm that the application was received and a subsequent email will be sent within 24-48 hours indicating whether the application was validated or rejected by the system.
