The National Transit Institute (NTI) is presenting the course "**State and Metropolitan Transportation Programming**" in Portland, OR on June 13-15, 2012 and Los Angeles, CA on June 19-21, 2012. Tuition shall be waived for federal, state and local government employees who work in transportation or related areas. This course provides instruction on the basic concepts, components, and participants in the transportation programming process. Current and best practices will be incorporated into the program.
