The purpose of this bulletin is to provide current information on your initial contact person at the Federal Transit Administration (FTA), Region 10 Office. Due to various organizational changes over the past year, FTA has made staff reassignments. Consequently, to assist you with information or questions regarding FTA programs and projects, or for assistance prior to starting a new grant application, we are enclosing a matrix in this bulletin, which lists each State within FTA's Region 10, the grantee or Urbanized Area (UZA) and the primary FTA point of contact. After that assignment, the grant processor will be your contact for **all issues pertaining to that grant.**
