Subject: Integrated Corridor Management Deployment Planning Grants

Program Area: Intelligent Transportation Systems

The U.S. Department of Transportation is seeking applications for Integrated Corridor Management (ICM) Deployment Planning Grants.

The request for applications invites states, Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPO), and local governments that intend to initiate or continue Integrated Corridor Management development with their partners, such as arterial management agencies, tolling authorities, and transit authorities, to apply for deployment planning grants.

The Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act (MAP-21) authorized the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) to encourage Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) deployment on the national highway system through demonstrations and grant programs. The purpose of this program is to promote the integrated management and operations of the transportation system, thereby improving multimodal transportation system management and operations.

The notice seeks applications for available funding for this program. Funding will be provided to cover a maximum of 80 percent of each proposed program/project. Total costs of each proposed program/project should not exceed \$200,000. Up to 10 awards are anticipated, but not guaranteed.

Formal applications must be submitted no later than December 31, 2013 to be assured consideration. Applications should be submitted through <http://www.grants.gov>.
