Subject: National Transit Database Information Collection Updates

Date: August 20, 2014

The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) published a notice in the Federal Register on August 19, 2014 that invites comments to revise certain aspects of National Transit Database (NTD) reporting guidance as described in the NTD Reporting Manual. The proposed revisions are prompted, in part, by enactment of the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act (MAP-21). The changes in this notice primarily relate to urbanized area transit providers. FTA is seeking public comment before implementing these changes to 49 U.S.C. 5335 National Transit Database. NTD is the FTA's primary database for statistics on the transit industry.

Comments must be received by September 18, 2014. Any comments filed after this deadline will be considered to the extent practicable.
