# OPT Funding Summary

Office of Public Transit

- Awarded \$4,500,000 from FFY 2017 Competitive Funding Opportunity Bus & Bus Facilities Infrastructure funds
- Funds will be used to implement OPT's Vehicle Replacement Initiative – Phase III
- Continuation of OPT's Five Year Vehicle Replacement Plan developed and Commission approved Oct. 2015
- 57 vehicles will be purchased for 12 rural subrecipients
- Contracts were issued to subrecipients March 2019.
