





Office of the Associate Administrator

- Office wide coordination and leadership
- Support functions
 - Budgeting
 - Stakeholder engagement



FTA WMATA Safety Oversight

- Carries out FTA's temporary and direct safety oversight of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority's Metrorail System
 - Inspections
 - Corrective Action Plans
 - Investigations
 - Tri-State Oversight Committee (TOC) under FWSO leadership carries out oversight related to Emergency Management, Safety Certification, and Triennial Audits
- Leading a transition process in which
 - FTA will transfer knowledge to the Washington Metrorail Safety Commission (WMSC)
 - WMSC will shadow FTA in the field
 - FTA will shadow WMSC and validate that the WMSC has the capacity to carry out its safety oversight responsibilities pursuant to federal transit law and its own program standard

Office of System Safety

- Design, development, implementation, and evaluation of safety policies, rules, standards, research, technical assistance, guidance and safety education based in SMS methods and principles
 - Risk-based safety oversight
- Current Efforts and Initiatives
 - Implementation of PTASP and Training rules
 - SMS pilots
 - TRACS
 - Building data collection, management, and analysis capacity to support risk-based oversight and program evaluation



Office of Safety Review

- Oversee compliance with the State Safety Oversight Program Rule and Prevention of alcohol misuse and prohibited drug use in Transit Operations
 - Implements these actions through audits, delivery of program guidance, and annual training workshops
- Supports the Emergency Management program and the Secretary's National Response Program
 - Executes mission essential functions (MEFs) and sustain essential government services (SEGs) during periods of disrupted operations from normal, alternative duty, and/or continuity of operation (COOP) locations, depending on the scope and potential duration of an event
- FTA supports the Secretary's responsibilities under the National Response Framework (NRF), Emergency Support Function - I (ESF-I) Transportation. Regional Emergency Transportation Representative (RETREP) coordination of disaster and special events planning efforts between DOT and Federal, State, local, Tribal and Territorial, and private sector emergency planners

Office of Program Oversight

- Conducts oversight activities to help ensure federal funds are used for their intended purpose and in compliance with regulatory and statutory requirements.
 - Comprehensive Reviews (Triennial & State Management)
 - Specialized Reviews (Procurement & Financial)
 - Training and Technical Assistance
- Current efforts and initiatives
 - 220 comprehensive reviews planned for FY19
 - Continued review streamlining
 - New avenues for workshop delivery
 - New oversight tracking system
 - Quality Assurance program





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
