### **Accident Definition**

§ 659.5

§ 674.7

No definition of accident

Accident means an event involving:

- a loss of life;
- a report of a serious injury to a person;
- a collision involving a rail transit vehicle;
- a runaway train;
- an evacuation for life safety reasons; or
- any derailment of a rail transit vehicle, at any location, at any time, whatever the cause.



49 CFR Part 674

#### **Accident Notifications** § 659.33 § 674.33

(a) The oversight agency must require the rail transit agency to notify the oversight agency within two hours of any incident involving a rail transit vehicle or taking place on rail transit-controlled property where one or more of the following occurs:

- (I) A fatality at the scene; or where an individual is confirmed dead within thirty (30) days of a rail transit-related incident:
- (2) Injuries requiring immediate medical attention away from the scene for two or more individuals; (3) Property damage to rail transit vehicles, non-rail
- transit vehicles, other rail transit property or facilities and non-transit property that equals or exceeds \$25,000:
- (4) An evacuation due to life safety reasons;
- A collision at a grade crossing;

revenue vehicle.

- A main-line derailment;
- A collision with an individual on a rail right of way; or (8) A collision between a rail transit vehicle and a

second rail transit vehicle, or a rail transit non-

(a) **Two-hour notification**.

In addition to the requirements for accident

notification set forth in an SSO program standard, an RTA must notify both the SSOA and FTA within two hours of any accident occurring on a rail fixed guideway public transportation system. The criteria and thresholds for accident notification and reporting are defined in a reporting manual developed for the electronic reporting system specified by FTA as required in § 674.39(b), and in Appendix A
