Agencies/State DOTs can call or email to...

- Ask a question directly to FTA
- Schedule a call with PTASP subject matter experts (SMEs)
- Request and schedule a review of your draft ASP



Objectives

- Rapid response to effectively support transit agencies, State DOTs, and SSOAs
- Prompt scheduling of ASP reviews
- Accurate, consistent information and application of Bus and/or Rail ASP Checklists



- FTA prioritizes and schedules onsite visits to support ASP development on an as needed basis.
- Scope, methodology, schedule, and other details of an onsite visit will vary depending on specific circumstances
- Can include:
 - Preparatory document reviews and virtual meetings
 - Onsite briefings and meetings
 - Training

 - First PTASP Implementation Status Survey
 - Analysis of the responses help shape the TAC
 - FTA will review and update resources in the TAC resource library, and adjust technical assistance, as needed.
